27th September Friendly Shoot Procedure

It will be a Friendly type shoot with 36 Mixed targets. Archers are requested to book in as requested above There will be no admin briefing at the start, archers will be checked in, NFAS cards as normal. Archers are requested to provide admin with full name, address, telephone number and email address at time of booking These will be kept in case of track and trace being required.

Score cards will be available for those wishing to score but there will be no prizes although score submitted will be put on website later, no raffle and no waiting around for scores at the end. Archers will be free to leave once they are finished or shoot again if they wish. Please inform admin prior to leaving. Site must be vacated at 6pm.

Groups will be shown to peg 1 or 19 and start shooting, subsequent groups to follow until all groups are out & shooting. Catering will be after target 18 or 36 as usual, but strict social distancing will apply (30 people max in catering area).

All Archers must be pre-booked.

All Archers are to bring their own face masks, to be used in admin area, and hand sanitizer and use them as required during shooting. We will have extra hand sanitizer available around the course.

Hand sanitiser must be used before and after touching any common surfaces, 3ds, bosses, seating areas, found

arrows etc.

Toilets will be available and hand sanitiser for use thereafter.

Limited catering will be available but numbers in catering area will be restricted (30 max).

Well behaved dogs, which must be on leads at all times, are welcome.

On arrival in the car park, social distancing must be applied. Book in with admin, NFAS cards will be checked.

Archers will have provided contact information for track and trace purposes.

General precautions

When moving around the course be aware of social distancing.

When scoring the target and pulling arrows. Approach the target one at a time, pull your own arrows, then stand back to allow other archers to pull their arrows.

Whenever possible, you must not touch the targets or bosses with bare hands. If you think you need to, you must sanitise your hands on completion.

When searching for lost arrows. You must use your own arrow rake, let the archer retrieve their own arrows once found. If you find any other arrows, they can be left in the lost arrows bin or given to a marshal, remember to sanitize your hands on completion.

Follow the Yellow arrows or tape to the next peg.

Normal NFAS safety rules apply, 3 whistle blasts to stop the shoot, if used 1 prolonged blast of an Air Horn will restart the shoot.

Should Government guidance change and impose more restrictions, that advice will supersede this guidance
